## **3. Transportation**

Upon arrival to Stockholm you are recommended to acquire a 1-week transportation ticket. The card is valid on all public transport in the Stockholm region including metro, busses, local trains and the boats. 1-week validity is calculated from the time of the first use of the ticket. The ticket can be in the form of a card or just downloaded to your smartphone. You can also use single tickets which can be purchased online using the app from SL or using a credit card. The easiest way to reach KTH campus is to take metro red line towards Mörby Centrum.

Upon arrival to the station Tekniska Högskolan you shall take the exit situated on the back of your train if you are coming from the city and in front of the train if you are coming from Mörby Centrum (the station has 2 exits) and then follow the signs towards Tekniska Högskolan.
